- Because travel delays happen, Steve prefers to arrive the night before. Please arrange or recommend a hotel that's either at the venue or nearby. Please make sure the room is non-smoking and non-pet.

Steve prefers not to convert his slides to templates as most slides are dynamic images rather than bullet points. If you have a logo you wish to add to the slides, Steve is happy to accommodate that.
